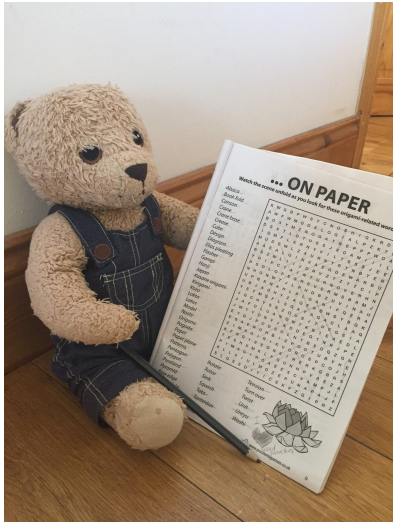


Jeremy's Diary 20th - 24th April 2020
