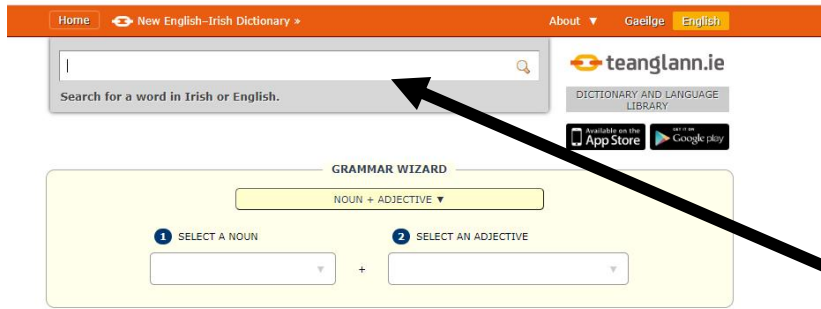


How to use Teanglann

If you search a word in Irish on www.teanglann.ie and then click 'pronunciation' on the right, you can listen to how the word is said.



1. Type the word in Irish into the search bar.
