Gaeilge


- Reading: Use Google Classroom to read and listen to books about how c, I, m, n, r sound in Irish
 - Choose one book to read a day. After listening to each word, say it out loud. After a few goes, challenge yourself to read the book without the voiceover.
- On Friday, complete a short quiz on Google Classroom based on the pictures and words from this week's phonic books.






