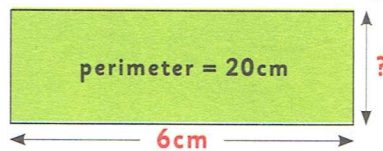

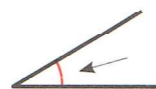
1. The sum of two numbers is 45. If one number is 17, what is the other number?
